

Photographic Competition 2021

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

The theme of the Photographic competition 2021 is "Our Glorious Parish". It's up to you to interpret this but we hope it will illustrate coming through the Covid 19 pandemic to a "brighter future". Twelve photos will be selected by renowned landscape photographer Derry Brabbs and will feature in the St Mary's Dunsforth Calendar 2022.

1. The competition is open to all amateur photographers living within the United Parish of Aldborough, Boroughbridge with Roecliffe, Dunsforth and Minskip. Photographs must have been taken within the Parishes.
2. The competition closes at midnight on Tuesday 31 August 2021.
3. Only digital (JPEG) images in LANDSCAPE format, at least 3,600 pixels wide and 2-3MB, sent by email to dunsforthphotocomp@icloud.com will be accepted.
4. By submitting images to the Photography Competition, each entrant confirms and warrants that:-
 - they are the sole author of each entry and that it is their original work;
 - they own the copyright and any other intellectual property rights of each image;
 - they have the permission of anyone pictured in the image (or, where the image shows any persons under 18, the consent of their parent/guardian) for the usage rights required by St Mary's Dunsforth and will indemnify St Mary's Dunsforth against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement;
 - they have not licensed or disposed of any rights in the image that would conflict with uses to be made by St Mary's Church Dunsforth;
 - they have received any necessary permissions from the owner(s) of objects including buildings included in submitted images for the usage rights required by St Marys Church Dunsforth and will indemnify St Mary's Church Dunsforth against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement.

If you are under the age of 18 you must have permission to enter from your parent or guardian. By submitting an entry for the competition, your parent/carer/guardian is deemed to have given such consent and to agree to the use of the entry as described in these terms and conditions.

The photographer retains all rights to the photos, however he/she grants permission to St Mary's Church to publish the winning photographs in 2022 Calendar and agrees to the image being cropped if necessary. Also grants permission to use the photographs in print and respective websites or in any other media. No fees will be payable for the above.

5. Each entrant should provide the photographer's name, (age if under 16) full address, email and phone numbers. Location the photo was taken, description including any known history of the subject and agrees to this information being published on the calendar
6. Maximum of 06 photographs may be entered per photographer.
7. All proceeds to St Mary's Church, Dunsforth.
8. Entrants will be judged by landscape photographer Derry Brabbs, whose decision is final.
9. The twelve winners will be notified by 15 September and published in the Parish Link. They will also be announced at the launch of the 2022 calendar, during a talk by Derry Brabbs in the autumn.
10. The winning photographs will appear in the calendar, receive 2 copies of the calendar and a complimentary ticket to the talk by Derry Brabbs.
